5th /6th Grade Division



SUMMARY

Our 5th/6th Grade Division recreational soccer teams will participate in a fall tournament. The teams are seeded based on regular season games, and each team will play three games in a round robin format. The top two teams with the highest points will advance to play in a full-length final game.

Each team will play one game on Sunday October 7th. Eight teams will play a game on either Monday October 8th or Tuesday October 9th at 6pm. Each team will play at least one game on Saturday October 13th ... with four teams playing two games on Saturday October 13th (the teams who have not previously played on Monday or Tuesday). The final game will take place on Sunday October 14th at 2:00pm at HSE Field #4. The championship game will be the two teams with the best round robin record.

Trophies will be given to the first and second place teams and all other teams will receive participation awards. All participation awards will be given to the coaches on the 13th for distribution to the team at their leisure. The first and second place trophies will be handed out at the conclusion of the championship game.

ROUND ROBIN GAMES

The tournament games will be played according to our 5th/6th Grade Division Club Laws with the following modifications:

Law 7 Game Duration. The round robin games will be reduced by 5 minutes per half ... each half will now be 25 minutes long. Be ready to begin play at your scheduled game time. Arrive early to warm-up.

Local Rules. Scores will be kept and standings will be based on points awarded to teams for each game as follows: Loss = 0 Points, Tie = 1 Point, and Win = 3 Points. The winning team's coach is responsible for notifying the commissioner of the results. All results from the games on the 7th, 8th, and 9th will be emailed to commissioner in a timely manner by the coaches.

CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The final game will be played according to our Division E Club Laws. It will consist of (2) 30-minute halves. Score will be kept.

Two teams will advance to this championship game based on points awarded in the three (3) round robin games. In the event that multiple teams tie, the tie will be broken according to the following procedures:

(Tie Breaker 1) Head to head results from round robin play (if teams played one another).

(Tie Breaker 2) The team allowing the fewest goals in the three round robin games will advance.

(Tie Breaker 3) The team scoring the most goals in the three games will advance.

WEATHER POLICY

Per our club rules, play will be stopped at the first sight of lightening or sound of thunder. Due to the time allowances and tight scheduling a make-up game will try to be scheduled but times will be very limited.

If a game is cancelled due to field or weather conditions, the game will be scored as a 0-0 tie, if a make-up game can not be scheduled.

If a game is cut short due to weather then the game will be scored as complete, if more than half the game is completed. If half the game is not complete a make-up game will be scheduled if possible. Points for the game will be awarded based on the score at the time the game was called.

If field or weather conditions completely prohibit play on October 7th, 8th, or 9th, we will make every attempt to reschedule for 10/10, 10/11, or 10/12. If conditions prohibit play on Saturday the 13th, the entire schedule will be moved to Sunday or the following week.
