



SUMMARY

Our High School Co-Ed Division recreational soccer teams will participate in a fall tournament. The teams will be divided into two flights that were randomly selected and each team will play three games in a round robin format. One team from each flight will advance to play in a full-length championship series.

Each team will play their first game on Sunday, October 7th their second and third games will be played on Saturday, October 13th. The championship game will take place on Sunday October 14th starting at 2:30pm.

Trophies will be given to the first and second place team and all other teams will receive participation awards. All participation awards will be given to the coaches on the 13th for distribution to the team at their leisure. The first and second place trophies will be handed out at the conclusion of the championship game.

ROUND ROBIN GAMES

The tournament games will be played according to our High School Co-Ed Division Club Laws with the following modifications:

Law 7 Game Duration. The referee reserves the right to reduce the length of the games to accommodate the time schedule. Be ready to begin play at your scheduled game time. Arrive early to warm-up.

Local Rules. Scores will be kept and standings will be based on points awarded to teams for each game as follows: Loss = 0 Points, Tie = 1 Point, and Win = 3 Points. Each coach is responsible for reporting the score to the commissioner. This can be done via email or phone.

CHAMPIONSHIP

The final game will be played according to our Division G Club Laws. Score will be kept.

One team from each flight will advance to this championship game based on points awarded in the three (3) round robin games. In the event that multiple teams from a single flight tie, the tie will be broken according to the following procedures:

(Tie Breaker 1) Head to head results from round robin play (if teams played one another).

(Tie Breaker 2) Total goal differential (max 4 per game).

(Tie Breaker 3) The team allowing the fewest goals in the three games will advance.

(Tie Breaker 4) MLS Shoot-Out.

WEATHER POLICY

Per our club rules, play will be stopped at the first sight of lightening or sound of thunder. Due to the time allowances and tight scheduling a make-up game will try to be scheduled but times will be very limited.

If a game is cancelled due to field or weather conditions, the game will be scored as a 0-0 tie, if a make-up game can not be scheduled.

If a game is cut short due to weather then the game will be scored as complete, if more than half the game is completed. If half the game is not complete a make-up game will be scheduled if possible. Points for the game will be awarded based on the score at the time the game was called.

If field or weather conditions completely prohibit play on Saturday, the entire schedule will be moved to Sunday or the following week.
