During tryouts, parents will be asked to not go to the tryout area with their child. This will allow the trainers to have your child's full attention.

U8 / U9 / U10 ACADEMY 2009-2010:

Based on the recommendation of the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) 'Best Practices Document', Fishers Soccer Club will be using the 'Academy' format for our U8/9/U10 players. All U8's, U9's, and U10's will participate in their age appropriate Academy League. The Academy program focuses on the development of EVERY player, from the strongest to the weakest. Skilled training staff develop each player's skills and game knowledge by working in groups and not on specific teams. It is this modern, player centered approach to learning that develops creative, competitive players who are not scared of making mistakes. This approach is proven to produce better quality soccer players. Games are played on a weekly basis against other travel programs using the 'Academy' format. They can expect to practice up to three nights a week (players make as many as they like) and play up to 8 games/season plus 2 tournaments, one of which is our Halloween Classic.

U11-U14 2009-2010:

These age groups will have teams designated as Red, White and Blue. The top team in each age group/gender will have a dedicated team trainer for all games and tournaments. The fees for the teams are listed below on the fee chart, plus an additional \$250 per player to cover the cost of the trainer attendance at all games and tournaments. White and Blue teams will have a team trainer running 2 practices per week and who will attend a minimum of 5 games per season. All teams will have the option to go to a "full trainer coverage format" for an additional \$250. Red, White and Blue teams will practice three days a week with one practice being designated as a group training night run by the FSC Director of Coaching. The focus in these age groups will be to develop every player to the best of their ability from both a technical and tactical standpoint, along with the strong emphasis on sportsmanship. Tournaments are budgeted into the fee structure, and teams may choose which tournaments to apply for upon approval by the DOC. The budget is enough to pay for approximately 4-5 tournaments per team, depending upon the cost of the individual tournaments. All teams participate in the Halloween Classic as one for their tournaments. A team can choose to attend more tournaments at an additional cost to the team. Trainer expenses on nonlocal tournaments will need to be covered per team.

COMMITMENT OF ALL TRAVEL PLAYERS:

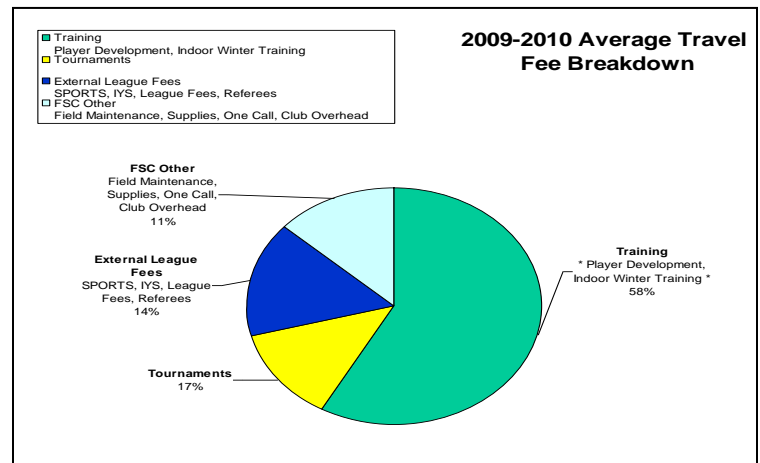
Travel Soccer involves a one year commitment of fall/spring seasons of 8 games each and winter indoor training. In addition to the player commitment, parents also must commit to activities including field maintenance and support of our Halloween Classic tournament which all teams participate in.

TRYOUT INFORMATION:

Tryouts are held at Cumberland Park (106th and Cumberland Road). Check in is 30 minutes prior to the start of tryouts. Each player should bring a ball, water and wear shin guards and proper footwear.

All players need to pre-register for tryouts whether your child can attend or not. The form can be found on the website www.fisherssc.org.

Following the conclusion of tryouts, teams will be posted on the Fishers Soccer Club's website, www.fisherssc.org. Players will have until **5pm on Sunday, June 28th**, to respond, either accepting or declining the team offer. Contact information, online registration information and uniform information will be on the website. The training staff will call any player who played for FSC this season who doesn't make a team for next season. NO phone calls will be made to players who tryout from outside the club and do not make a team. They must check the teams listed online. If a player turns down the chance to play on a team, the training staff will contact the next player from the team below to offer a spot. This will be done as quickly as possible.

All HSE resident players who try out and do not make a travel team or who choose not to accept our offer to play will be given the opportunity to register for our recreational soccer program between June 28 and July 2. The late fee will be waived and players will be guaranteed placement on a team. Completed registration forms must be delivered in person to either the Rec Director or SPORTS office (9am-12noon, 12690 Promise Road) with full payment. Any player who registered in May for our 2009-2010 recreational program and has accepted an offer to play on one of our travel teams will be granted a full refund. U8, U9, U10 MEET THE COACHES NIGHT/UNIFORM ORDERING:

Date: Monday, June 29th **Time:** U8/U9: 6:30PM U10: 7:30PM

Location: Fishers Conference Center adjacent to the Hilton Garden Inn, 9775 North By Northeast Blvd (I69 and 96th Street behind McDonalds and FedEx Kinkos)

A brief welcome meeting will be held where Board Members, the Director of Coaching, the Club Registrar, the Uniform Coordinator, and coaches and trainers will be introduced. Immediately following this welcome meeting, the players and their parents will gather with their trainers and coaches to discuss the fall season (tournaments, league games, practices). Players will also size and order uniforms (**CHECKS ONLY**). **All U8, U9, and U10 players and parents are asked to attend.** Note that there will be an alternate uniform ordering session on July 7th (see below) for those that cannot make the meeting on June 29th. *Also note that all uniform orders must be placed by July 7th in order to guarantee arrival by the beginning of the season.*

U11-U14 UNIFORM ORDERING SESSION:

Location: Cumberland Park Building (106th Street and Cumberland Road)

This session is offered for all new U11-U14 FSC Travel players and returning players that need additional apparel. Those who cannot attend this session may attend the alternate uniform ordering session on June 29th from 6:30PM - 8:30PM at the Fishers Conference Center (see above). *Note that all uniform orders must be placed by July 7th in order to guarantee arrival by the beginning of the season.* Meetings with U11-U14 teams will take place at a later date.

REGISTRATION:

Registration will be done online. Once an offer is made to a player for a FSC team, the parent should go onto the FSC website, www.fisherssc.org and click on the Online Registration 2009-2010 box. This will take you through the online registration process. Any questions regarding registration should be addressed to registrar@fisherssc.org.

There are two payment options to choose from to cover the base registration fees:

Option 1: Pay the full amount due for the base registration fee at the time of online registration. You may make this payment by credit card or echeck.

Option 2: Pay ½ the Base registration fees at the time of online registration. This can be done by credit card or echeck. The remaining ½ of the base fees due, MUST be paid by Sept. 1, 2009. All payments for the remaining balances due will be paid online thru the FSC website link and must be paid by credit card or echeck. Players will not be allowed to continue with their team if full payment is not received by this date. There will be no other payment options offered.

NOTE: Any family that is being awarded financial assistance will be required to pay their portion of all of the fees due by the same deadlines. This includes the base registration fees, uniform fees, trainer fees and any other fees incurred by your child's specific team budget

In addition to the base registration fees you will pay for the 2009-2010 year, an additional trainer fee of \$250 may be due depending on the team level your child plays on. All \$250 trainer fees will be billed separately and will be collected around the time of the first practice in August. Parents will need to pay the trainer fee online using a credit card or echeck. All trainers fees must be paid in full before player cards will be processed and distributed.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Fishers Soccer Club (FSC) believes in providing a quality soccer experience at all age levels and capabilities for a reasonable cost. While FSC considers our fee structure to be competitive, the club also recognizes that for some, this fee may be prohibitive. Therefore, FSC has adopted a financial assistance policy that is designed to be fair and appropriate. Although FSC does not wish to see any interested, qualified child refused an opportunity to participate because of cost, the club also realizes that not all applications can be approved, and discretion must be used when analyzing financial assistance requests.
